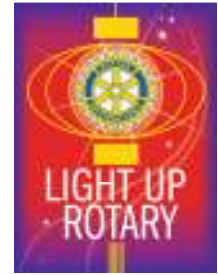

This Week's Speaker will be

Laura Senturia, founder and president of Emily's Hope



Emily's Hope is a Virginia-based, volunteer run non-profit. Ms. Senturia, a graduate of Brandeis University, spent the first 10 years of her professional life working in Public Affairs and Public Relations before changing careers to become a teacher. Ms. Senturia currently works full time as an elementary school teacher in Fairfax County, Virginia. Following the tragic passing of one of her fourth grade students, Ms. Senturia worked with her students and colleagues to find a way to add meaning to the tragedy. Emily's Hope, which works to enrich the lives of children locally and globally in various ways, is a way to honor the life of Emily Michael and make a positive difference in the world, one school or one child at a time. She will share background on the inspiration behind the nonprofit, its mission, and the results of its first project--a school in Malawi. She will also share plans for the organization's future projects closer to home.
