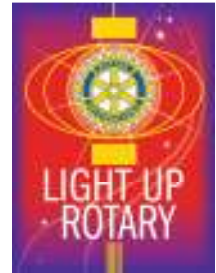

## **This Week's Speaker will be Erik Brady**



**Seeing Sports Nationally - and Locally.** Erik Brady is a sports reporter at USA TODAY, where he writes national sports stories. He has lived in Arlington for 32 years and sees sports from a local perspective too. Erik Brady was born in Buffalo on the day Roger Bannister ran history's first sub-four-minute mile, apparently destining him to his ink-stained, lucky life as a sports reporter. He began his career at the (Buffalo) Courier-Express, which folded the same week in 1982 that USA Today began, and he has been working for the national paper since. He and his wife Carol Stevens, communications chief of the American Bar Association, have lived in three Arlington neighborhoods since their arrival from Buffalo — Waverly Hills, Madison Manor and Williamsburg. They have two grown children who also live in Arlington, Steve in North Rosslyn and Claire in Madison Manor. Steve's wife, Shannon, is a kindergarten teacher at Arlington's Abingdon Elementary School. Erik is a board member of the Better Sports Club of Arlington.
