

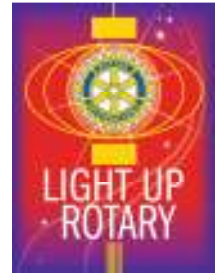

This week's speaker will be technology innovator, John Carney
