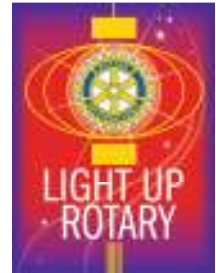

Through grassroots community development, they empower youth and women with art as therapy and entrepreneurship education, enabling them to bring vital resources to their communities. Connecting development programs with international classrooms, they enrich global education with participatory and service learning.



Jason has seventeen years of experience with management consulting firms, non-governmental organizations, and in higher education. That experience includes working and living in the Americas, Eastern Europe, Asia, and Africa, and serving clients from a variety of different industries. He holds a B.S. in business administration from the University of Mary Washington and an MBA from American University.
