Chartered July 4, 1929 – Now In Our 85th Year

This Week we will hear from Bill Knight, CEO of World Police & Fire Games, to be held in Fairfax, VA, from June 26-July 5, 2015



Bill Knight is a 25-year veteran of some of the biggest sporting events in the world. He is also the guiding force behind Fairfax 2015, a massive undertaking responsible for staging multiple simultaneous events that include both individual and team sports as well as police and fire specific competitions. Knight brings to the Games a legacy which includes executive-level positions at the 1994 FIFA World Cup USA, the 1996 Atlanta Summer Olympics, Super Bowl XXXIV and served as Senior Vice President for the Eagle International Group where he worked on the Ryder Cup in 1997, the US Senior Open Golf Championship in 1998 and the FIFA 2001 Women's World Cup. He later served as Managing Director of Sportscape, LLC, a management consulting, sales strategies, event and facility planning firm.
