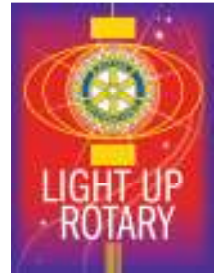

Langston HS Cont. Ed. is a small program located between the McDonald's and Heidelberg Bakery on Lee Highway that catches the students who do not (for whatever reason) thrive in a traditional high school setting. For the past three years its students have had the opportunity to visit various Virginia universities and this exposure has inspired them to further expand their education. In fact, from a previous trip to University of Virginia (UVA), two of their students were so inspired they applied to UVA and were accepted. They are currently both studying medicine with goals to become doctors and several other former students are now attending Old Dominion University (ODU), Norfolk State University (NSU), Virginia State University (VSU), Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) and Christopher Newport University. In the past, Langston was supported by the Arlington Community Foundation and the Office of Minority Achievement of Arlington Public School. This support that provided transportation is no longer available due to budget cuts and shortfalls and program restrictions so they need raise a total of \$1,800 to pay for this year's college tour bus trip scheduled for May 20, 2015.

Our club does not have funds allocated to support this out of its AREF account, but some members have already pledged personal donations and we hope others will consider doing the same.
