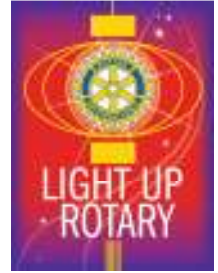

It is important that all members make an effort to attend.

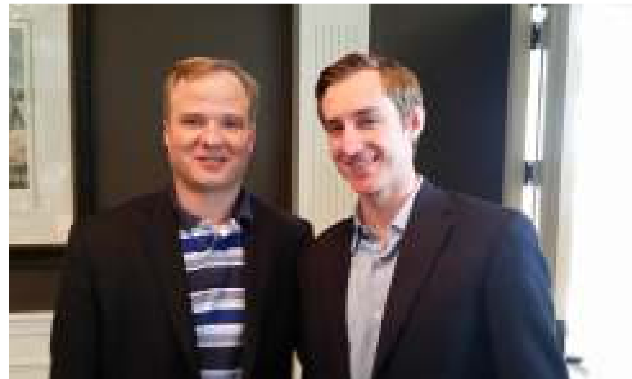


A club flag was given to a couple of visiting Rotarians from Japan (left).
