She previously worked for the Natural Resources Defense Council (an environmental nonprofit) and Environ Corporation (an environmental consulting firm). Joan received her BA from Williams College and a Master's degree from the Yale University School of Forestry and Environmental Studies.

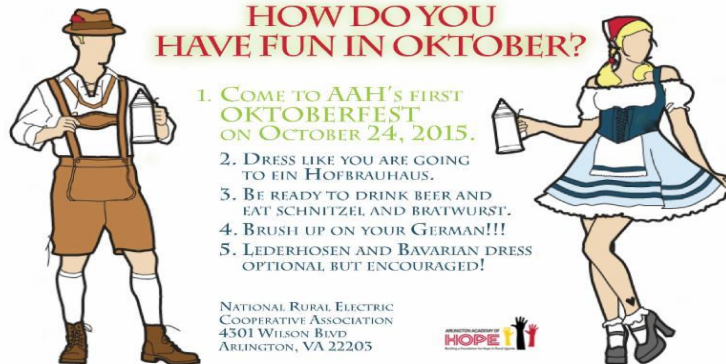
