THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER IS

Lorraine Tong

“My eight years in the Senate as a Legislative Aide for Foreign Policy”



Lorraine Tong worked for Senator Alan Cranston (D-CA) and his Legislative Aide for Foreign Policy, and for Senator Jacob Javits (R-NY) as his China advisor. Her areas of responsibility included U.S. relations with China, Russia, and the Middle East.

She also worked on nuclear arms control, and human rights. She represented Senator Cranston on congressional trips to China, Taiwan, and South Korea.

She has taught legislative process to congressional staff. An immigrant who grew up in California, she received her degree in International Relations at Stanford University.

Lorraine will talk about her experience working in the Senate from 1977-1985 on foreign policy for two Senators. She will share highlights of what it was like to work on the Hill and the lessons she learned.


