Jerome Tennille, Manager, Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (TAPS)



"Overview of TAPS" -- the basics of the mission, history, and services TAPS provides and ways to get involved. We'll cover how the organization was founded 22 years ago, the core programs, how the services are provided and the impact volunteers have nationwide.
