## Midday Program: August 11, 12:10 PM at the WGCC Maurice Middleburg, Executive Director, Free the Slaves “The Modern Anti-Slavery Movement”



Maurice I. Middleberg has worked in international development and social justice for 30 years, including projects for CARE in 50 different countries for CARE, USAID, the Futures Group, IntraHealth International, and others. He earned his B.A. in history from Temple University and pursued doctoral studies in political science at American University, and has taught at Columbia and Emory. As Executive Director of Free the Slaves, he oversees the organization’s wide range of anti-trafficking initiatives around the globe, and guides the group’s policy advocacy, corporate engagement, and awareness-raising programs in the U.S. Today, he will address the landscape of modern day trafficking and slavery, what Free the Slaves is doing to eradicate it, and what it will take to end of slavery in our lifetime

### Last Week

Prof. Robert J. Lieber of Georgetown University discussed his latest book, *Retreat and Its Consequences*, in which he argues that the policies of “retreat and retrenchment” that have characterized U.S. foreign policy in the past 7+ years threaten to make the world a more dangerous place unless the U.S. resumes a more robust leadership role.
