## **Midday Program: October 13, 2016 - 12:15 PM at WGCC** **Jean Henceroth, Board Member, My Friend Mayvis Foundation** **“He Never Hit Me, But ...”**



The prevalence of physical abuse is often talked about. The first question asked when a woman seeks help for domestic violence is “has he ever hit you?” Society has clearly conveyed to the domestic bully that it is not okay to hit your wife! But, what about those that have never been hit? What about those that have been systematically controlled, isolated from family and friends, and broken down with wounds too deep to be visible to those around them? What then? How does society help a victim when the victim is too damaged, scared, and broken down to help herself? When the justice system’s hands are tied, there has to be another means to set victims free, and the answer is a *friend*.

Jean has 25+ years’ experience in nonprofit fundraising, and commercial and corporate banking. Working with the Susan G. Komen Foundation and the American Red Cross, she conducted successful major gift campaigns and special events. Her efforts in research and proposal writing resulted in grants over \$5 million annually.
