Midday Program: November 10, 2016 - 12:15 PM at WGCC **Dr. Paul Williams, Associate Professor, George Washington U.** **“Imperatives for Global Action on African Security”**



How can the USA support effective peace operations in Africa? Africa remains the site of more armed conflicts and peace operations than any other region of the world. We have a range of political, security, humanitarian and economic interests in ensuring these peace operations are effective.

Paul D. Williams is Associate Professor in the Elliott School of International Affairs at the George Washington University. Dr. Williams is also a Non-Resident Senior Adviser at the International Peace Institute in New York where he manages the “[Providing for Peacekeeping Project](#).” He is the author and editor of numerous books including *War and Conflict in Africa* (Polity, revised

2nd edition, 2016); *Enhancing U.S. Support for Peace Operations in Africa* (Council on Foreign Relations Special Report No.73, May 2015); and *The Oxford Handbook of United Nations Peacekeeping Operations* (Oxford University Press, 2015)
