Tony Brock

“Intelligence Drives Operations – Managing Information for Effective Decision-Making”



Information overload threatens business leaders' ability to conduct strategic planning and effective decision-making. Tony Brock, a retired Navy SEAL Team intelligence officer, outlines the issues and explains a six-step process for leaders to take charge of their business intelligence cycle. He provides combat-proven techniques to attain superior results.

Tony Brock is a retired Navy Commander and intelligence officer who served multiple tours with U.S. Navy SEAL teams; and as the U.S. Naval Attaché to Hong Kong and Macau. His personal awards include the Bronze Star and Defense Superior Service Medals. He graduated from University of Maryland (MBA), University of Florida (International Relations), the Defense Language Institute (Chinese, Mandarin), and the CrossLead Executive Course with McCrystal Group.
