“How Accurate Are Virginia’s Voter Rolls?”



The discussion will cover some of the challenges Virginia and Arlington election officials face in maintaining accurate voter registration rolls. We'll cover legal requirements and steps taken to assure the rolls are as accurate as possible.

The Arlington Electoral Board appointed Linda Lindberg General Registrar for Arlington County in 2003. Her first election management experience was as an Arlington County poll worker in 1992. In 1994 she joined the staff of the Office of Voter Registration as Deputy Registrar.

The Office of Voter Registration, where she serves as chief administrator, is responsible for maintaining Arlington’s list of registered voters and conducting elections.

Linda has served three separate terms as co-chair of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments’ (MWCOG) Election Officials Technical Committee, is active in the Voter Registrars’ Association of Virginia, and has provided assistance on a number of special projects and task forces for both the Virginia State Board of Elections, where she is currently serving on the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS) Change Control Committee, and the U.S. Election Assistance Commission.

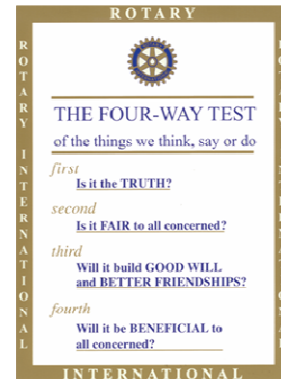
