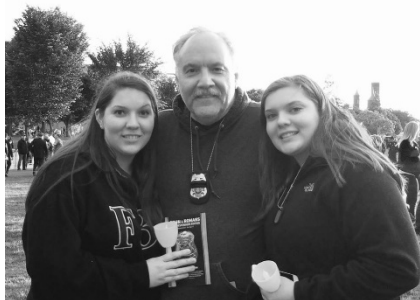

Speaker: Sgt (Ret) Robert "Bob" Bauer, MA, JD and Founder, Warriors Heart USA
"Invisible Wounds"



Robert is a retired law enforcement officer who has served as a Deputy Sheriff, Criminal Investigator, Federal Law Enforcement officer for over 4 decades. He has held positions of leadership that oversaw a gang task force, patrol operations, and was a senior law enforcement officer for security and police operations at a major research facility in Virginia. He has been a professor of criminal justice; and is an author, professional personal coach, and advocate for community policing. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, a Master's in Counseling and a Law Degree.

Bob is Founder and CEO of **Warriors Heart USA**, a non-profit organization focused on building peer-to-peer networks to help law enforcement officers and their families navigate through the minefields of life. Warriors Heart has sponsored: **Campaign Thank You**; a week before Police Week where the community is asked to show Random Acts of Kindness towards Law Enforcement Officers; **Blessing Sunday**; the first Sunday after Police Week when local churches are asked to recognize the members of their church that are Law Enforcement Officers and collectively pray for them; and **Adopt A Cop; 100 Days of Prayer**, which asks individuals to adopt a law enforcement officer or agency and pray for them for 100 Days (July 1 - Oct 8, 2017). They are also building networks where Law Enforcement Officers can freely seek guidance from a retired Law Enforcement Officer who will offer confidential empathetic listening. The newest Project is a crisis line for the District, Maryland, and Virginia where there are over 90,000 sworn law enforcement officers; Local, State, and Federal, as well as retired and families
