Speaker: Dr. Lois Wilson, DDS, Past President, McLean Rotary Club
“Vocational Training Team Project in Swaziland”



Dr. Lois Wilson is a practicing General Dentist and the recently appointed Chief Dental Officer for HealthWorks for Northern Virginia, a Community Health Center providing accessible health care for all. She is a longtime member and past president of the Rotary Club of McLean. Dr. Wilson served as the District 7610 Group Study Exchange Team Leader for 2006-2007 and served as the District 7610 GSE Coordinator in 2009-2010.

Dr. Wilson is co-founder with Michelle "Meesh" Peters of the MicheLo Program that was created from the Group Study Exchange with then District 9250 of Southern Africa. In 2014 she received the RI Service Above Self Award for the work done by the MicheLo Program.

Her presentation will highlight the evolution of a locally grown, Rotarian led, and District supported Vocational Training Team International Project, in the Kingdom of Swaziland that has expanded through partnerships.

Warriors' Heart, aimed at providing advice and counseling to officers who are experiencing stress and other problems.
