Alan Button joined Arlington Rotary back in January this year, transferring from a club in Wisconsin. Get to know Alan better as he tells us about himself and his life.



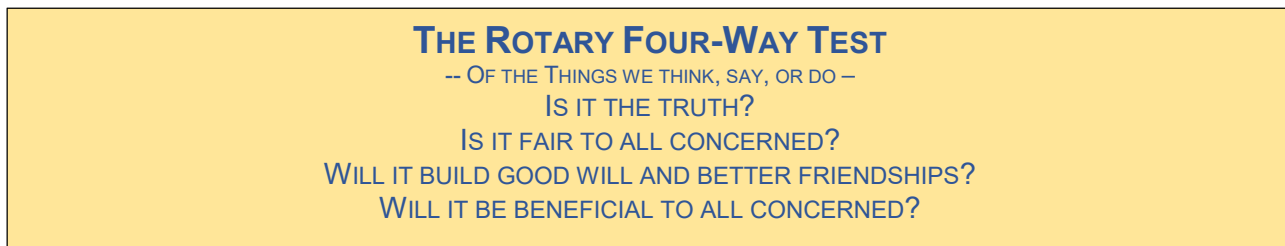
Last Week
