Thursday, February 15 - Lunch Program at the WGCC, 12:15-1:30 Robert Stauss - Burtelson Security Labs



Robert Stauss is a US Army-trained security expert and ethical hacker, one of the world's leading experts on technical social engineering, who writes and lectures on social engineering-based cyber-attacks. He is trained and certified by the Department of Homeland Security in operations security (OPSEC) and cyber-security.

In 2015 Mr. Stauss founded Burtelson Security Labs, a cyber-physical security firm that maintains a 100% success rate of being able to penetrate the security of any system they are hired to test – which is done to test a company's security controls to shore up their security weaknesses before the bad guys can exploit them.

Robert's fascination with hacking, computers and telecommunications began in the late 1980s when his grandfather, a telecommunications engineer and executive for AT&T, taught Robert about phone phreaking, a form of phone hacking and exploration of the phone system.
