ARC members may recall Nadia Stewart from her visit with us last spring, when she introduced us to Empowering Enrichment and its mission: to bridge the gap for students and communities with financial need who would not otherwise have access to educational enrichment programs. As a result of her talk, our club provided a \$3000 grant to fund scholarships to one local school's PTA-sponsored Enrichment Program. This Thursday, Nadia returns to recap EE's 2017 year, provide a look at what's coming for this year, and discuss the positive impact that our grant had on the schools community, Empowering Enrichment's organizational success, and goals for 2018.

Nadia is the Executive Director of Empowering Enrichment. She graduated from Ohio University with a B.S. in Organization Communication in 1999 and received a M.S. from The George Washington University in Education Technology Leadership in 2003. Prior to co-founding Enrichment Matters, she provided training systems analysis and instructional design expertise to various government agencies.
