Chrissy has been with Urban Alliance (UA) since 2015, serving as Program Coordinator and Program Director before becoming Executive Director (ED) of the Northern Virginia region. As ED, Chrissy forms partnerships with for-profit, non-profit, and government organizations to provide paid, year-long internships to economically-disadvantaged high school seniors in Arlington, Alexandria, and Fairfax. She dedicates herself to empowering others to realize their full potential. Her topic today is: "Business Nonprofit Teamwork to Disrupt the Poverty Cycle"

Prior to arriving at UA, Chrissy served as Co-Director of The Peace Project in Nicaragua, where she led enrichment, literacy, ESL, and scholarship programs, and worked with Partners of the Americas, where she coordinated

hands-on agricultural training by US volunteers in Latin America. Her most formative experience was her time with WorldTeach as an English instructor in Cuenca, Ecuador.

Chrissy holds an M.A. in Social Enterprise from American University and a B.A. in International Studies and Spanish from Johns Hopkins University.

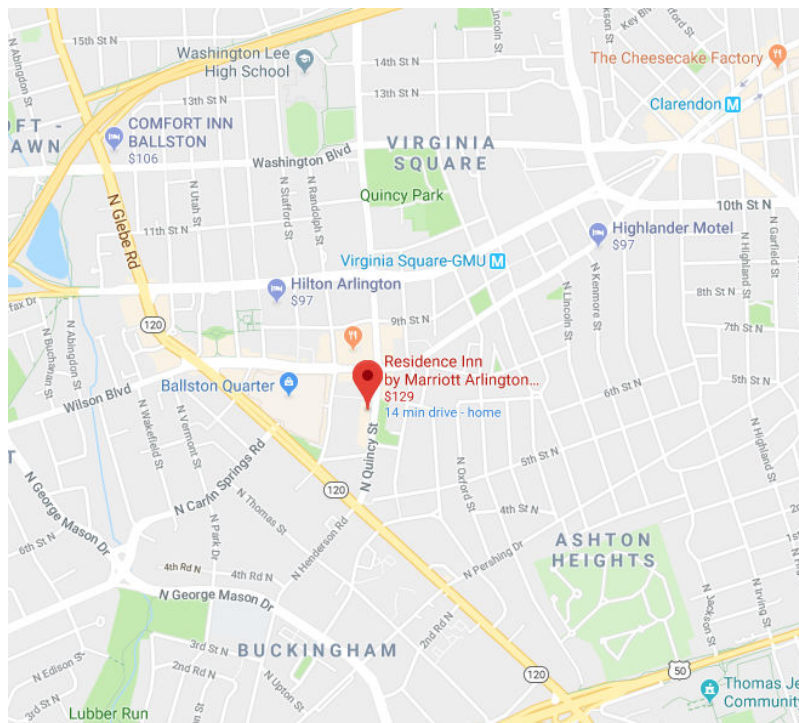

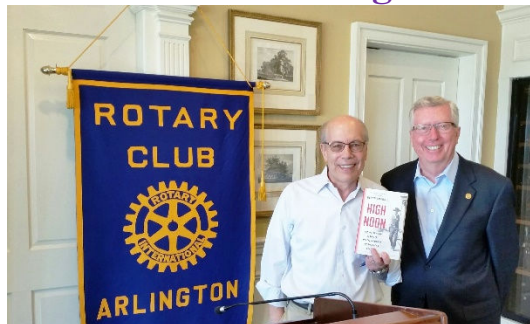

Last Week's Meeting



Our speaker at Rotary last week was Glenn Frankel, a former Washington Post foreign correspondent who recently wrote/published *High Noon: The Hollywood Blacklist and the Making of an American Classic*, a combination of film history with political history. Mr. Frankel had a lot of interesting information to impart, for example offering insights into how the big studios were giving way to independent directors/producers at that time, how Gary Cooper's career was affected by that, and the political backdrop of the blacklist and Senator McCarthy. In his talk he drew some parallels between those times and our own, as "many of our national institutions failed" to perform the functions we would expect of them.
