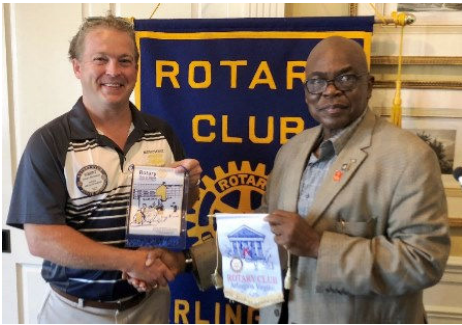

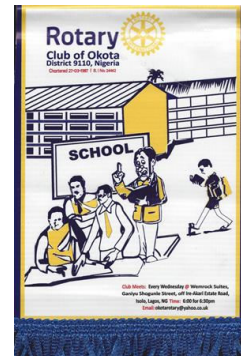
Silence Those Cell Phones!
