Holly Koons is the executive director of the Arlington Arts Center, where she oversees the administration, development, and creative strategy of this non-profit organization dedicated to contemporary visual arts. Prior to assuming her current position in 2016, she amassed twenty years of experience in non-profit visual arts curation and management. From 1996 – 2011, Koons worked at the Telfair Museums in Savannah, Georgia, where she served as the Director of Collections and Exhibitions. After relocating to northern Virginia in 2011, Koons served as the part-time curator at the Greater Reston Arts Center, eventually assuming the dual position of director/curator. Koons holds a BA in art history and English from the University of Georgia, and a MA in art history from the University of Notre Dame.

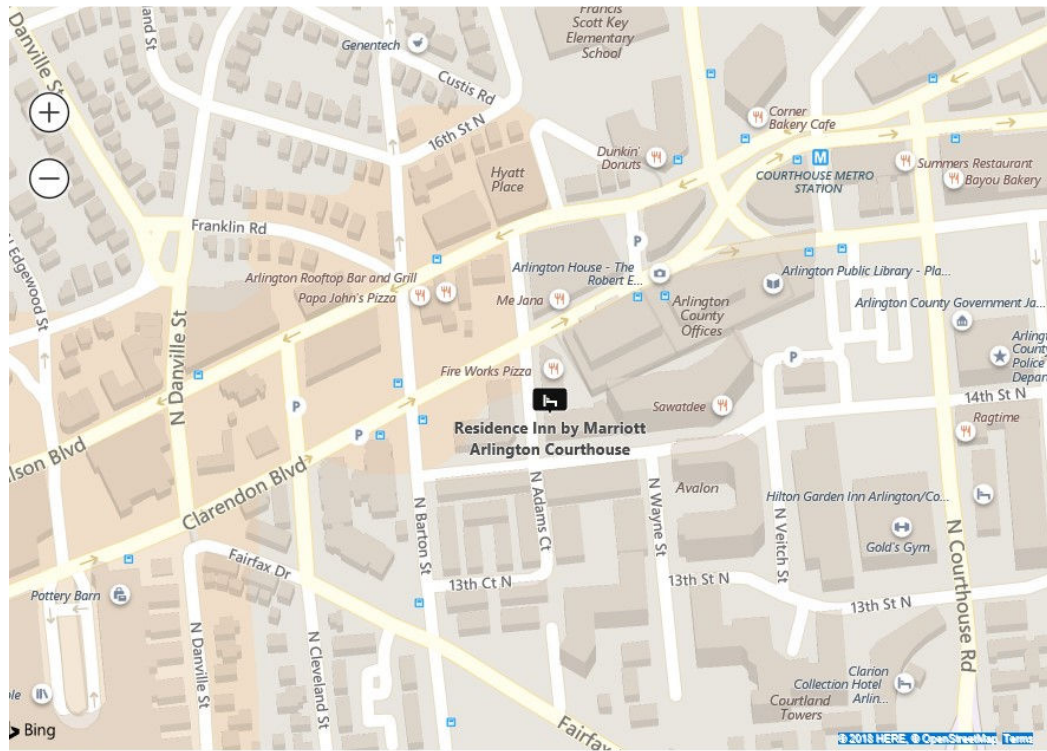
