Arlington Free Clinic is a nonprofit organization that provides free health care to low-income, uninsured adults through the generosity of volunteers and donors. The clinic's 32 staff members and 550+ volunteers provide primary and specialty care, mental health services, physical therapy, pharmacy, and dental care for more than 1600 Arlingtonians each year.

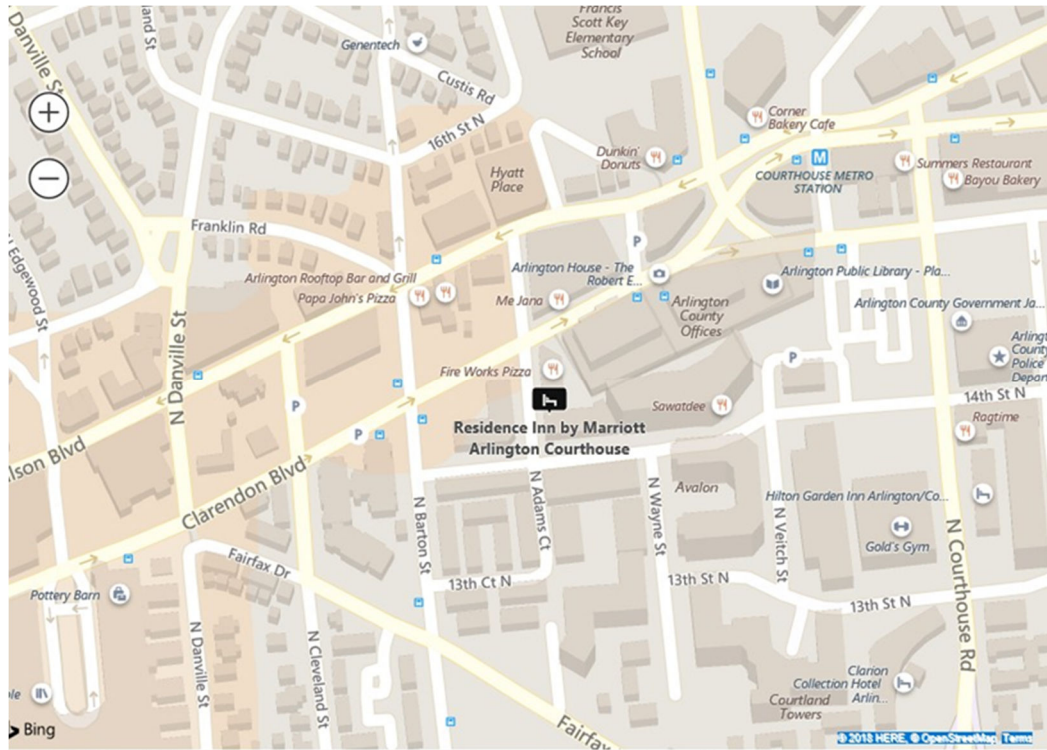

She the AFC's physical therapy program in 2002 in partnership with Marymount University.
