Liz Nohra received her bachelor's degree from Youngstown State University and a Master's from the Cooperstown Graduate Program in Museum Studies. Upon graduation she worked at the Cleveland Children's Museum. After moving back to Youngstown in 2000, she became Assistant Director at the Mahoning Valley Historical Society and Arms Family Museum of Local History, where she was later named Manager of Education and External Relations. In 2004, Nohra became Executive Director of the Children's Museum of the Valley. She was named a "40 Under 40" honoree in 2005 by the Community Foundation of the Mahoning Valley and Mahoning Valley Professionals 20/30, of which she was a founding board member. She has also served on the boards of the Boys and Girls Club of Youngstown, and as a

volunteer with the Junior League of Youngstown, the YWCA, and the Junior Group of Goodwill. She is also a proud graduate of Leadership Mahoning Valley, Class of 2005.

Nohra moved to Northern Virginia in 2008 and accepted a position at Leadership Fairfax, Inc. before taking her current position as Chief Operating Officer at Leadership Center for Excellence here in Arlington. She is a resident of south Arlington.
