Ms. Jones has 30 years of experience working with vulnerable families and youth impacted by domestic violence, sexual abuse, and homelessness, and 18 years of Executive Nonprofit Leadership. She earned her Master's Degree in Clinical Social Work from Boston College and Certification in Nonprofit Executive Leadership from Georgetown University, yet points to her work with clients as her greatest source of learning and continuous inspiration. She leads with a fundamental focus on helping people in crisis using equity- and trauma-informed approaches. She is a committed leader and advocate for our community and state; actively volunteering with groups focused on solving social issues related to sexual/domestic violence, homelessness,

and economic advancement for women and marginalized populations. Among these, she Co-chairs Arlington's Youth Homelessness Task Force and Project PEACE's Implementation Task Force. In 2016, she was appointed to serve, and now Chairs, Virginia's Sexual and Domestic Violence Professional Standards Committee. Caroline and her family have called Arlington home since 1995.

Callie Nierenberg started the Change for Life Foundation with her husband after his godchild was diagnosed with cancer at an early age. CFL raises funds that go 100% to children's cancer research efforts that could not be funded otherwise. Their main event, staged at MGM National Harbor with a poker tournament, silent auction, and a Las Vegas style party with live music and food from the best DC chefs, raised \$1.6 million last year. An engaged committee of over 70 women work year-round on organization, ticket sales, sponsor solicitation, and amenities. Social media and the "Instagramability" of the event are key for their success as are their contacts in DC and 15 years history of the foundation.
